

## This is a practical activity

**Resources:** For each pair - a piece plain paper, a pencil.

### Step One

Rule and Instruction

Show respect and good manners at all times.  
*Teacher/ facilitator to insert appropriate instruction.*

### Step Two

Randomly Paired

As a change from ready-made pairing cards you could use different ways of expressing dates e.g. (1.05.11 / 1st May 2011).

### Step Three

Meeting and Greeting

Hello (*insert partner's name*). It's good to be paired with you.

### Step Four

Activity

One of the children draws five black dots on the piece of paper, well spaced out. Their partner then draws a small circle around each of the dots. Share out the activity. *Think about* and decide who will draw the dots and who will draw the small circles. Once the drawing is done, take it in turns to join the circles with straight lines. Look at the finished drawing. *Think about* it and then decide with your partner whether it reminds you of anything.

### Step Five

Plenary

Taking turns and sharing is important.

Question: What kind of things is it important to take turns about at school?
